STATEMENT OF CHARGES

12 On or about October 24, 2018, JESSE JAHNER, a certified peace officer with
13 the Tacoma Police Department (TPD), was discharged for disqualifying misconduct
14 pursuant to former RCW 43.101.105(1)(d) (2011) and RCW 43.101.010(8) (b) (2008).
15 The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime committed under
16 color of authority, to wit: Official Misconduct. RCW 9A.80.010. The disqualifying
17 misconduct is as follows:

18 **Count I**

19 On or about June 5, 2017, JAHNER, while on duty as a peace officer and with
20 the intent to deprive another person of a lawful right or privilege, intentionally committed
21 an unauthorized act under color of law and/or intentionally refrained from performing a
22 duty imposed upon him by law. As a result of these events, on or about
23 February 2, 2023, JAHNER was convicted of the crime of Official Misconduct
24 (RCW 9A.80.010) in Pierce County Superior Court case no. 19-1-00257-5.
