STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about February 14, 2022, JARED CORSON, a certified peace officer formerly with the Everett Police Department, was found guilty of a gross misdemeanor domestic violence offense. RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(i)(B). This conviction prevents him from possessing a firearm. RCW 9.41.040(2)(e). On the same date, CORSON was also found guilty of crimes constituting disqualifying misconduct pursuant to RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv). The circumstances are as follows:

**Count I**

On February 14, 2022, CORSON was found guilty of a gross misdemeanor domestic violence offense, to wit: Stalking Domestic Violence. RCW 9A.46.110(1), RCW 9A.36.041(4) (2017), and RCW 10.99.020. This finding of guilt means that CORSON was convicted of this crime as that term is defined by RCW 43.101.010(4). CORSON’S criminal conviction violates RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(i)(B). CORSON was a certified peace officer at the time he engaged in the misconduct that resulted in this criminal conviction. RCW 43.101.105(2)(a)(ii)(B).

**Count II**

The conduct described in Count I also constitutes a violation of RCW 43.101.105(2)(e), as CORSON’S conviction prohibits him from possessing a firearm under state law. RCW 9.41.040(2)(a)(i).

AND/OR

**Count III**

On February 14, 2022, while employed as a peace officer, CORSON was found guilty of RCW 9A.80.010 (Official Misconduct) and of RCW 9.73.030 and RCW 9.73.080 (Privacy Act violations). Such criminal conduct fails to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer as well as disrupts, diminishes, or otherwise jeopardizes the public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession. RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
