**AMENDED STATEMENT OF
CHARGES**

On November 4, 2020, MICHAEL CASSATT, a certified peace officer with the Orting Police Department (OPD), was discharged for disqualifying misconduct pursuant to former RCW 43.101.105(d) (2011), former RCW 43.101.010(8)(a)(i)(B) (2020) and former RCW 43.101.010(8)(b) (2020). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime of dishonesty or false statement within the meaning of Evidence Rule 609(a), to wit: Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant. RCW 9A.76.175. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I

On multiple occasions between January 2018 through March 2020, CASSATT engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant when he knowingly provided falsified timekeeping, attendance, and other work-related records to his public employer, OPD. RCW 9A.76.175.
