STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about June 22, 2021, LOREN MEADOR, a certified peace officer with the Renton Police Department, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct as defined by former RCW 43.101.105(1)(d) (2011) and former RCW 43.101.010 (8)(a)(i)(B) and RCW 43.101.010 (8)(b) (2020). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime involving dishonesty or false statement within the meaning of Evidence Rule 609(a), to wit: Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant. RCW 9A.76.175. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I – False Statements Made to Fellow Officers

On or about May 7, 2021, while on-duty as a peace officer, MEADOR was involved in a collision in his patrol vehicle. That day, MEADOR engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public Servant when he knowingly provided false or misleading material statements to responding officers concerning this collision. MEADOR knew that the officers would likely rely upon his false or misleading statements in the discharge of their official duties. RCW 9A.76.175.

1 AND/OR

2 **Count II – False Statements Made in Incident Report**

3 On or about May 8, 2021, while on-duty as a peace officer, MEADOR engaged
4 in conduct constituting the crime of Making a False or Misleading Statement to a Public
5 Servant when he knowingly made false or misleading material statements in a City of
6 Renton Incident Report concerning the on-duty vehicle collision referenced in Count I.
7 MEADOR knew that public servants with the City of Renton would likely rely upon his
8 false or misleading statements in the discharge of their official duties. RCW 9A.76.175.

9 The discharge is final and some or all of the acts or omissions forming the basis
10 for the discharge proceedings occurred on or after January 1, 2002.
11 Former RCW 43.101.105(1)(d) (2011).
