STATEMENT OF CHARGES

12 On or about October 04, 2021, DANIEL MALLOY, a certified peace officer with  
13 the King County Sheriff's Office (KCSO), resigned in lieu of termination after engaging  
14 in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace  
15 officer; disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the  
16 law enforcement profession; or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold the  
17 officer's sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the  
18 state of Washington. Such misconduct subjects MALLOY'S peace officer certification  
19 to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k). The circumstances are as  
20 follows:

21 **COUNT I**

22 On or about November 6, 2020, while on duty as a KCSO deputy, MALLOY  
23 engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required  
24 of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or  
25 confidence in the law enforcement profession; and/or demonstrated an inability or  
26 unwillingness to uphold his sworn oath to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United

1 States and the state of Washington when he: (1) made inappropriate and unwelcome  
2 sexual advances and/or physical contact with a female civilian at her workplace; and/or  
3 (2) worked as a pilot instructor while under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or other  
4 intoxicants. MALLOY'S conduct violated KCSO Policy 3.00.015(2)(k) – Conduct  
5 Unbecoming, and his peace officer certification is subject to discipline under  
6 RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).

7 AND/OR

8 **COUNT II**

9 On or about October 4, 2021, MALLOY resigned in lieu of discharge from the  
10 KCSO after engaging in the misconduct alleged in Count I. MALLOY'S peace officer  
11 certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
