STATEMENT OF CHARGES

RYAN DAVIS

12 On or about July 6, 2022, RYAN DAVIS, a certified peace officer with the 13 Issaguah Police Department (IPD), resigned in lieu of termination from that agency. 14 Following his separation from IPD, DAVIS engaged in conduct that, through fraud or 15 misrepresentation, used the position of peace officer for personal gain. Additionally, 16 DAVIS failed to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer. 17 Such misconduct subjects DAVIS'S peace officer certification to discipline under 18 RCW 43.101.105(3)(g) and RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv). The circumstances are as 19 follows:

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Count I

On or about September 12, 2022, DAVIS engaged in conduct that, through fraud
or misrepresentation, used the position of peace officer for personal gain. Specifically,
with the intention of securing a work position reserved for employed peace officers,
DAVIS falsely indicated to a company representative that he was an employed officer
with IPD and provided documentation in support of this falsehood. DAVIS'S peace
officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(g).

| 3 | On or around September 12, 2022, DAVIS engaged in conduct that failed to meet |
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| 4 | the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer when he falsely told |
| 5 | IPD Corporal Nathan Lane that his supervisor provided the company representative |
| 6 | with documents in support of the falsehood that DAVIS was employed with IPD. In fact, |
| 7 | DAVIS provided these documents to the company representative. DAVIS'S peace |
| 8 | officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv). |
