STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Respondent.

On or about December 9, 2022, MARK RAYSBROOK, a certified peace officer with the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) was terminated by his employer after he knowingly made misleading, deceptive, untrue, or fraudulent representations in the practice of being a peace officer. Such misconduct subjects RAYSBROOK'S peace officer certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(2)(d) and (3)(k). The circumstances are as follows:

## Count I

On or between October 2 and October 26, 2022, RAYSBROOK knowingly made misleading, deceptive, untrue, or fraudulent representations in the practice of being a peace officer when he: (1) knowingly made a false report via radio to SCSO dispatch regarding his collision with a fire hydrant; and/or (2) knowingly made false or misleading oral statements to SCSO Sergeant Luis Zelaya regarding his collision with a fire hydrant; and/or (3) knowingly recorded misleading, deceptive, or false statements in a sworn police report he authored regarding his collision with a fire hydrant; and/or (4) knowingly made misleading, deceptive, or false statements to SCSO

1	Sergeant Jason Tift during an internal investigation interview regarding his collision with
2	a fire hydrant. As a result of this misconduct, RAYSBROOK was terminated from
3	employment with SCSO on or about December 9, 2022. RAYSBROOK'S peace officer
4	certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(2)(d).
5	AND/OR
6	Count II
7	On or about December 9, 2022, RAYSBROOK was discharged by SCSO after
8	engaging in the misconduct described in Count I. RAYSBROOK'S peace officer
9	certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
