Such misconduct subjects OLVERA'S peace officer 22 certification to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv) and (3)(k). The circumstances 23 are as follows: 24

COUNT I

On or about February 25, 2023, OLVERA engaged in conduct that failed to meet
the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, diminished
or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement profession;
and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold his sworn oath to enforce
the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington when he:
(1) engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Assault in the Fourth Degree –
Domestic Violence, contrary to RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv); and/or (2) made false or
misleading statements to one or more officers with the Bremerton Police Department;
and/or (3) interfered with the statement of a potential witness. OLVERA'S peace officer
certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
AND/OR
COUNT II
On or about June 14, 2023, OLVERA was discharged or otherwise separated
from employment with the KCSO after engaging in the misconduct described in Count I.
OLVERA's peace officer certification is subject to discipline under
RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
