Such misconduct subjects BANKS' peace officer certification to discipline 20 under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv). The circumstances are as follows: 21 COUNT I 22 On or between January and May 2023, BANKS engaged in conduct that failed 23 to meet the ethical and professional standards required of a peace officer; disrupted, 24 diminished or otherwise jeopardized public trust or confidence in the law enforcement 25 26 profession; and/or demonstrated an inability or unwillingness to uphold her sworn oath

1	to enforce the Constitution and laws of the United States and the state of Washington
2	when she: (1) with the intent to embarrass or harm another law enforcement officer,
3 4	sent anonymous and harassing text messages and emails to the officer's chief, spouse,
5	and two media outlets; and/or (2) misleadingly told the Whitman County Sheriff's Office
6	and others that she sent an anonymous email to the officer's chief and/or media outlets
7	as part of her duty to intervene. As a result of this misconduct, on or about June 23, 2023
8	BANKS was found to have violated the following PPD policies: 7 2.31.7 (Criminal
9	Conduct), 7 2.31.6 (Verbal Abuse and Harassment), 7 2.4 (Proper and Ethical
10	Procedures in Discharging Official Duties and Responsibilities), 7 2.31.17
11	(Contemporary Community Standards). Additionally, BANKS was found to have
13	violated the following PPD directives: 319.5.8 (Performance), and 319.5.9 (Standards
14	of Conduct). BANKS' peace officer certification is subject to discipline under
15	RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv).
