STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Respondent.

12 On or about January 1, 2023, the Washington State Criminal Justice Training 13 Commission (Commission), received а complaint alleging that 14 ROGER MORNINGSTAR, a certified peace officer, engaged in unethical conduct while 15 employed with the Quinault Indian Nation Police Department (QPD). The Commission 16 later determined that MORNINGSTAR resigned in lieu of termination from the QPD after 17 engaging in sexual harassment. Additionally, on or around June 2, 2023, 18 MORNINGSTAR resigned in lieu of termination from the Morton Police Department 19 (MPD) after engaging in sexual harassment, knowingly falsifying or omitting material 20 information on an application to an employer, and engaging in conduct that failed to 21 meet the ethical and professional standards of a peace officer. Such misconduct 22 subjects MORNINGSTAR'S peace officer certification to discipline under 23 RCW 43.101.105(3)(f), RCW 43.101.105(3)(c), RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv), and 24 RCW 43.101.105(3)(k). The circumstances are as follows:

Count I

Between approximately October 2012 and April 1, 2015, MORNINGSTAR
engaged in sexual harassment against subordinate female officers employed at the
QPD. After engaging in this misconduct, MORNINGSTAR resigned in lieu of termination
from the QPD on or around April 1, 2015. MORNINGSTAR'S peace officer certification
is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(f).

7 AND/OR

Count II

Between approximately January 1, 2016 and June 2, 2023, MORNINGSTAR
engaged in sexual harassment against subordinate female officers employed at MPD
and/or other female coworkers employed with the City of Morton. After engaging in this
misconduct, MORNINGSTAR resigned in lieu of termination from the MPD on or around
June 2, 2023. MORNINGSTAR'S peace officer certification is therefore subject to
discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(f).

Count III

17 In or around December 2015, MORNINGSTAR knowingly falsified information in his application for employment with MPD by: (1) providing false, incomplete, and/or 18 misleading answers in response to polygraph examination questions, and/or; 19 (2) providing false, incomplete, and/or misleading information during an interview with 20 21 Rodger Cool, who conducted a background investigation on behalf of MPD, and/or; 22 (3) providing false, incomplete and/or misleading information to Dr. Bill Ekemo, who conducted a psychological examination on behalf MPD. MORNINGSTAR'S peace 23 24 officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(c).

Count IV

2 Between approximately October 2012 and June 2, 2023, MORNINGSTAR engaged in conduct that failed to meet the ethical and professional standards of a peace 3 officer when he: (1) failed to appropriately respond to an incident involving an attempted 4 5 burglary on or around February 22, 2023, and/or; 2) made false and/or misleading statements in reports regarding the February 22, 2023 attempted burglary incident, 6 7 and/or; 3) made false/and or misleading statements to other MPD officers and officers with the Lewis County Sheriff's Office, and/or; 4) made sexually suggestive comments 8 to and engaged in inappropriate physical contact with female citizens, and/or; 5) failed 9 10 to properly address allegations of sexual harassment involving an MPD officer he supervised, and/or; 6) sexually harassed subordinate female officers and other 11 coworkers, and/or; and 7) made false and/or misleading statements when applying for 12 13 employment with MPD. MORNINGSTAR'S peace officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(iv). 14

Count V

On or about June 2, 2023, MORNINGSTAR resigned in lieu of termination from
his employment with the MPD after engaging in the misconduct alleged in Count II,
Count III, and Count IV. MORNINGSTAR'S peace officer certification is therefore
subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(k).
