NIEDER's peace officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i), (3)(f), and (3)(j)(iv). The circumstances are as follows:

COUNT I

On or about November 26, 2020, NIEDER engaged in sexual intercourse with R.J., an adult female who was incapable of consent by reason of being physically helpless or mentally incapacitated. On or about October 12, 2022, Detective Emily Wolfe with the Skagit County Sheriff's Office issued an Affidavit of Probable Cause finding that NIEDER committed the felony offense of Rape in the Second Degree – RCW 9A.44.050. NIEDER'S peace officer certification is therefore subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i).

COUNT II

On or about September 24 and 25, 2022, NIEDER engaged in sexual intercourse with A.S., an adult female who was incapable of consent by reason of being physically helpless or mentally incapacitated. On or about October 12, 2022, Detective Emily Wolfe with the Skagit County Sheriff's Office issued an Affidavit of Probable Cause finding that NIEDER committed the felony offense of Rape in the Second Degree – RCW 9A.44.050. NIEDER'S peace officer certification is subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(3)(j)(i).
