9 **I. COMMISSION'S CONSIDERATION**

10 A. Default. This matter has come before the Criminal Justice Training  
11 Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to RCW 43.101.155(1), WAC 139-06-050(3), and  
12 RCW 34.05.440(1). On June 16, 2020, the Certification Manager Tisha Jones issued a  
13 Statement of Charges ("SOC") seeking to revoke John Arredondo's peace officer  
14 certification based on disqualifying misconduct. The Hearing Coordinator, Kayla Wold, sent  
15 the SOC along with the required Peace Officer Certification Request for Hearing Form  
16 ("Hearing Request") and a declaration of service to John Arredondo ("Respondent") on June  
17 18, 2020, by Certified Mail. The Certified Mail piece was unclaimed, and a public notice was  
18 placed on CJTC's webpage.

19 The Respondent did not request an adjudicative hearing within sixty calendar days of  
20 service of the SOC and Hearing Request as required by RCW 43.101.155(1) and  
21 WAC 139-06-050(2).

22 B. Record Presented. The record presented to the Commission for review and for  
23 entry of a final decision included the following:

- 24 1. Statement of Charges *In Re Certification of John Arredondo* issued by Tisha  
25 Jones.

1 2. Peace Officer Certification Request for Hearing Form sent to John Arredondo  
2 on June 18, 2020.

3 C. Factual Findings and Grounds for Order. Pursuant to RCW 43.101.155(1),  
4 WAC 139-06-050, and RCW 34.05.440(1), the Commission finds that the Respondent was  
5 properly served with the SOC and Hearing Request and has failed to respond or otherwise defend  
6 against the SOC within the time provided by law. As a basis for its findings and order, the  
7 Commission hereby adopts, affirms, and incorporates the SOC.

## 8 II. FINAL ORDER

9 Based upon the foregoing and the Commission having considered the record and being  
10 otherwise fully advised, NOW, THEREFORE:

### 11 A. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 12 1. The Respondent is in default and has waived his opportunity to  
13 contest the allegations contained in the SOC.  
14  
15 2. The Respondent's Peace Officer Certification is REVOKED.

16 B. Reconsideration. Pursuant to RCW 34.05.470, you have ten (10) days from  
17 the mailing of this Order to file a petition for reconsideration stating the specific grounds on which  
18 relief is requested. No matter will be reconsidered unless it clearly appears from the petition for  
19 reconsideration that: (a) there is a material clerical error in the Order, or (b) there is specific  
20 material error of fact or law. A petition for reconsideration, together with any argument in  
21 support thereof, should be filed by mailing or delivering directly to the Washington State Criminal  
22 Justice Training Commission, 19010 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South, Burien, Washington, 98148, with a copy  
23 to all other parties of record and their representatives. Filing means actual receipt at the  
24 Commission's office. RCW 34.05.010(6).

25 A timely Petition for Reconsideration is deemed denied if, within twenty days from the  
26 date the petition is filed, the Commission does not (a) dispose of the petition or (b) serve the


1 parties with a written notice specifying the date by which it will act on a petition. An order  
2 denying reconsideration is not a prerequisite for filing a petition for review.

3 C. Stay of Effectiveness. The filing of a petition for reconsideration does not  
4 stay the effectiveness of this Order. Any such requests should be made in connection with a  
5 Petition for Judicial Review made under chapter 34.05 RCW and RCW 34.05.550.

6 D. Judicial Review. Proceedings for judicial review may be instituted by filing  
7 a petition in superior court according to the procedures specified in chapter 34.05 RCW, Part V,  
8 Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement (RCW 34.05.510 through .598). The petition for judicial  
9 review of this Order shall be filed with the appropriate court and served on the Commission, the  
10 Office of the Attorney General, and all parties within thirty (30) days after service of this Order,  
11 as provided in RCW 34.05.542.

12 E. Service. For purposes of filing a Petition for Reconsideration or a Petition  
13 for Judicial Review, service is effective upon deposit of this order in the U.S. mail, declaration of  
14 service attached hereto.
