STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about March 8, 2019, CODY S. MCCOY, a certified peace officer with the Snohomish County Sheriff’s Office, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct pursuant to RCW 43.101.010(8)(b) and (9). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime committed under color of authority as a peace officer, to wit: Failure of Duty and/or Official Misconduct. RCW 42.20.100, RCW 9A.80.010. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I

On or about December 9, 2018, MCCOY, while on-duty as a peace officer, engaged in sexual activity with a civilian. This activity constitutes a willful neglect to perform MCCOY'S lawful duty as a peace officer. Additionally, during this activity MCCOY intentionally refrained from performing his police duties, which deprived the public of its right to unhindered police availability.

AND/OR

1 **Count II**

2 On numerous occasions between October 3, 2018 and January 22, 2019,
3 MCCOY, while on-duty as a peace officer and without the permission of his supervisor,
4 drove his patrol vehicle to a private residence outside of his assigned patrol area. This
5 activity constitutes MCCOY'S willful neglect to perform his lawful duty as a peace officer.
6 Additionally, during this activity MCCOY intentionally refrained from performing his
7 police duties, which deprived the public of its right to unhindered police availability.

8 The discharge is final and some or all of the acts or omissions forming the basis
9 for the discharge proceedings occurred on or after January 1, 2002.
10 RCW 43.101.105(d).
