STATEMENT OF CHARGES

Respondent.

On or about July 19, 2020, SEAN M. CARR, a certified peace officer with the Washington State Patrol, was discharged for disqualifying misconduct as defined by RCW 43.101.010 (8)(a)(i)(B) and (b). The disqualifying misconduct included conduct constituting a crime committed under color of authority as a peace officer, to wit: Official Misconduct and/or Failure of Duty. RCW 9A.80.010, RCW 42.20.100. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I

Between February 2012 through November 2019, while on-duty as a peace officer, CARR engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Official Misconduct when he intentionally used state resources to facilitate sexual activity with a female on multiple occasions for his own personal benefit. While engaging in this activity, CARR intentionally refrained from performing his duties as a peace officer. RCW 9A.80.010.

1 **Count II**

2 Between February 2012 through November 2019, while on-duty as a peace
3 officer, CARR engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Failure of Duty when he
4 engaged in sexual activity with a female on multiple occasions. While engaging in this
5 activity, CARR willfully neglected to perform his duties as a public officer.
6 RCW 42.20.100.

7 AND/OR

8 **Count III**

9 Between February 2012 through November 2019, while on-duty as a peace
10 officer, CARR engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Official Misconduct when he
11 created and sent numerous sexually explicit images and videos to a sexual partner for
12 his own personal benefit. While engaging in this activity, CARR intentionally refrained
13 from performing his duties as a peace officer. RCW 9A.80.010.

14 AND/OR

15 **Count IV**

16 Between February 2012 through November 2019, while on-duty as a peace
17 officer, CARR engaged in conduct constituting the crime of Failure of Duty when he
18 created and sent numerous sexually explicit images and videos to a sexual partner.
19 While engaging in this activity, CARR willfully neglected to perform his duties as a public
20 officer. RCW 42.20.100.
