STATEMENT OF CHARGES

On or about September 25, 2017, John F. Bogen (Respondent) a certified peace officer with the Bremerton Police Department was discharged for disqualifying misconduct pursuant to RCW 43.101.010(8)(b) and (9). The disqualifying misconduct was conduct that would constitute a crime involving dishonesty or false statement within the meaning of Evidence Rule 609(a) to wit: Making a false or misleading statement to a public servant. RCW 9A.76.175. The disqualifying misconduct is as follows:

Count I

On or about December 30, 2016, the Respondent knowingly made false or misleading material statements to Sergeant Timothy Garrity when Respondent told Sergeant Garrity that he had destroyed paraphernalia related to Bremerton Case B16-10206. Sergeant Garrity relied upon this statement when he submitted a clarifying email regarding evidence in this case to the city prosecutor. This conduct constitutes **Making a false or misleading statement to a public servant** a violation of RCW 9A.76.175.

1 AND/OR

2 **Count II**

3 On or about March 31, 2017, during Respondent's interview, the Respondent
4 knowingly made false or misleading material statements to Lieutenants Randy Plumb
5 and Mike Davis in stating that he did not tell Sergeant Garrity that he had destroyed
6 the paraphernalia related to Bremerton Case B16-10206. This conduct constitutes
7 **Making a false or misleading statement to a public servant** a violation of
8 RCW 9A.76.175.

9 The discharge is final and some or all of the acts or omissions forming the
10 basis for the discharge proceedings occurred on or after January 1, 2002.
11 RCW 43.101.105(1)(d).
