

October 4-8, 2021. WSTOA 50-hour Basic SWAT Course



50 Hours of Training over 5 days

DuPont, WA

This course is designed for officers and deputies newly assigned to SWAT and Tactical Response Teams. Students will gain the understanding of contemporary theories and concepts used during SWAT operations. Students will participate classroom and field exercises designed to develop techniques and strategies employed during tactical operations.

Schedule

Day 1

History, NTOA-PFQ, Team Structure, Missions-Tactics-Techniques, Overview of Barricaded suspect and high-risk search warrant ops. Immediate Actions Drills and Air-Purifying Respirators. All day's end with Team Building EX

Day 2

Breaching, IAD exercises, Fighting from vehicles, arrest team tactics, Less-Lethal Philosophy and Chem Agent Practical exercise and Team Building

Day 3

Building clearing practical, Tactical Medicine, Reality Based Scenarios and Team Building

Day 4

Scouting, tactical diagraming, Operations Orders. Arrest Team, shield rescues, and ARV rescues. Incident Debriefs, intro to Hostage Rescue and Team Building.

Day 5

Reality Based training incorporating all the courses, written test and the highly coveted rite of passage for all new Washington SWAT officers - the Mark Renninger Run followed by your graduation.

Learning Objectives

- SWAT Theory & Concepts in order to gain an understanding of SWAT utilization during tactical operations. The National SWAT Standards and Washington State Best Practices
- SWAT History, Liability, Functional Fitness/Wellness and Resiliency
- Team organization and structure, to include the responsibilities of each position within the team.
- Overview of specialized equipment and munitions used by SWAT Teams.
- Tactics used during armed barricaded incidents and high risk warrant service missions.
- Proper Scouting and Operational Plan & the necessity of after-action reviews.
- Dynamic, Slow and Methodical, and Covert Tactics
- Mission Based Movement Techniques

Instructed by experienced and vetted team leaders from Tier 1 and Tier 2 Washington SWAT teams.
