About this Webinar: As the use of body-worn cameras (BWCs) continues to expand, police agencies now face the enormous challenge of analyzing the vast amount of data that BWCs record. Recent innovations funded by the Department of Justice as well as private sector companies are transforming the potential to turn BWC video into a powerful asset to improve operations, training, and performance management. This webinar focuses on projects in Dallas, St. Petersburg (FL), Kinston (NC), and other police agencies that are teaming with Polis to analyze body-worn camera (BWC) videos and help identify best practices in de-escalation, trust-building, and other elements of safe and effective policing.

Goals and Objectives:

After completing this webinar, participants will be able to:

- Use evidence-based practices to analyze BWC videos, agencies can identify and reinforce patterns of success, as well as identify situations where better tactics, procedures, policies, and training could help improve outcomes.
- Explain why BWC video is their agency's largest source of data on police-community interactions.
- Explain how new technology can improve the efficiency, accuracy, and objectivity of BWC data analysis.

- Identify steps their agency can take to adopt a more positive, evidence-based approach to BWC data analysis.
- Explain the role of BWC data analysis in supporting other kinds of police data analysis such as crime rates, use of force rates, commendations/complaints, and community satisfaction/trust.
- List and explain some of the key legal, ethical, and operational issues related to BWC data analysis.
