The City of Enumclaw will be establishing an eligibility list for immediate hire.

The City of Enumclaw is approximately 45 minutes southeast of Seattle Washington in King County. The current population is approximately 11,600 residents. The city sits on the Enumclaw Plateau, nestled in the midst of green fields and picturesque dairy farms. The Cascade Mountains along with Mt. Rainier offer a dramatic backdrop for our community. Enumclaw is an outdoor enthusiast's dream and is known as "The Gateway to Mt. Rainier" with easy access to world class skiing, hiking, climbing, hunting and fishing.

The Enumclaw Police Department provides 24-hour law enforcement support to the City of Enumclaw. The Enumclaw Police Department has 33 employees covering the Patrol, Investigations, Communications and Corrections divisions. Our mission is to provide quality, professional, effective and proactive law enforcement in partnership with the community to ensure a safe and secure environment in which to live, work and visit.

For Entry Level Applicants, the City of Enumclaw partners with Public Safety Testing to administer the initial testing for all entry level officer positions. Once those tests are complete, qualified candidates will be invited to proceed to an oral board process conducted by the Enumclaw Police Department in conjunction with the Civil Service Commission. Oral Boards are scheduled according to employment needs. If you are interested in an entry level position, please apply at www.publicsafetytesting.com or call 1-866-HIRE-911. You are encouraged to contact them for test dates and requirements. After passing those evaluations, please mail your application to the city using the address on the application.

We will be interviewing candidates in the order of their Public Safety Testing written exam scores beginning with the highest score during our Oral Boards which we expect will be held in sometime in the next two months. Once it is determined you qualify for this round of testing, you will be notified of your interview time by email. If you are not one of the top scoring candidates, you will be contacted for an interview time if/when the higher scoring candidates have been eliminated from consideration. The city sends no formal notification to applicants who are not selected to continue in our process.
