## **Requirements**

Candidates must be able to successfully complete the following:



Complete the selection process which includes, but is not limited to an application packet, pre-interview questionnaire, oral interview, background investigation, polygraph, Chief's interview, psychological and medical evaluation.



Complete an approved basic law enforcement academy within the state where they served, and served as a commissioned law enforcement officer for at least two (2) years.



Out of state candidates must be able to successfully qualify for and complete the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission's (CJTC) Equivalency Academy.



Have not had a break in full-time law enforcement employment of twenty-four (24) months or greater.

The City of Battle Ground offers a generous benefits packages including:

### Vacation

Ninety-six (96) hours per year to start; prior years of commissioned law enforcement service may be considered for a higher starting accrual rate

Accrue eight (8) hours of sick leave each month

Twelve (12) paid holidays computed at time-and-onehalf pay rate, and 12 additional hours of annual paid time off
