



The Washington State Patrol will be sponsoring an Emergency Vehicle Operator Instructor Course in 2021 for Commissioned Law Enforcement Officers. This is a five-day course. The course will be held at the Washington State Patrol Academy in Shelton, Washington.

The dates are: May 3-7, 2021
July 12-16, 2021
December 6-10, 2021 (Full)

This intense and challenging course is designed for officers who are currently assigned, or will be assigned, as Full- or Part-Time EVOC Instructors. **Students must have a CJTC Basic driving certification or Basic Law Enforcement driving certification in their state.** The course covers Legal Issues, Commentary Drives, Vehicle Dynamics, Non Emergency, Emergency, Night and Pursuit driving. Each student will also develop skills in advanced vehicle placement and skid avoidance/recovery exercises.

The registration fee will be \$1,576.28 and will include tuition, vehicle usage, and training materials. If lodging and meals are required, lodging is \$37.00 per night, \$8.00 for meals, and \$5.00 for a salad bar. If utilized, your bill will be adjusted and your agency will be billed at the conclusion of the training.
