The ACT program is a court security program designed to directly enhance personnel's capabilities in advanced threat awareness skills and allows for a proactive approach to observe and identify threat indicators that exist in the human and courtroom environment. This program can save lives.

Because courthouses are vulnerable to acts of random violence, they must have proper court security procedures, not only to protect the safety of the people and property within and around the courts, but also the integrity of the judicial process. While there is no one solution to issues concerning court security, many current security training programs focus on reactive versus proactive solutions. This course is the opposite, focusing on proactive safety measures that can prevent violence.

Attendees will learn how to establish baselines in their environment and how to recognize certain anomalies that indicate potential threats through human behavior, body language and environmental awareness. This can assist agencies in forming new protocol that creates a safer environment.
