Three-Day BTMITP Program Focus

The Basic Tactical Medical Instructor Training Program is a highly intense training program requiring a physical demand on the student and consists of lecture, labs and skill practice. The Law Enforcement Officer will gain knowledge and skills necessary to mitigate the loss of their life or the life of another while in an active threat environment. The skills will address treating life threatening injuries in an austere environment with limited equipment, lack of medically trained personnel and prolonged time to evacuation.

Who Should Attend

Applicant must be a law enforcement officer/agent with arrest authority in the prevention, detection, apprehension, detention and/or investigation of felony and/or misdemeanor violations of federal, state, local, tribal, or military criminal laws. Some programs will allow Direct Law Enforcement Support Personnel (DLESP), see program prerequisites for specifics.

Cost
