STATEMENT OF CHARGES

14 On or about January 16, 2024, YOUNG, a former corrections officer with the
15 Chelan County Regional Justice Center (CCRJC), was terminated from his employment
16 after knowingly making misleading, deceptive, untrue, or fraudulent representations in
17 the practice of being a corrections officer. YOUNG's corrections officer certification is
18 subject to discipline under RCW 43.101.105(2)(d). The circumstances are as follows:
19

20 **COUNT I**

21 On or about January 16, 2024, YOUNG was terminated from employment with
22 the CCRJC after his employing agency found that he knowingly made misleading,
23 deceptive, untrue, or fraudulent statements in the practice of being a corrections officer.
24 Specifically, CCRJC found that YOUNG was knowingly dishonest when he: (1) falsely
25 told his supervisor that he completed his "board and picture" checks, despite knowing
26

1 he had not completed these checks; and/or (2) falsely recorded completing jail floor
2 checks, despite knowing he had not completed these checks. YOUNG's corrections
3 officer certification is subject to mandatory revocation under RCW 43.101.105(2)(d).
