

COUNT I

On or about January 16, 2024, YOUNG was terminated from employment with the CCRJC after his employing agency found that he knowingly made misleading, deceptive, untrue, or fraudulent statements in the practice of being a corrections officer. Specifically, CCRJC found that YOUNG was knowingly dishonest when he: (1) falsely told his supervisor that he completed his "board and picture" checks, despite knowing

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| 1 | he had not completed these checks; and/or (2) falsely recorded completing jail floor |
